TRAVELLING RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP
2016-17**

This Travelling Fellowship has been endowed with the object of assisting women graduates who have considerable experience of research (at least and often beyond the doctoral level) and who intend to undertake fieldwork projects outside the British Isles (and normally not within their own countries of residence or citizenship) in Biology, Archaeology, Social Anthropology or Sociology, with preference for Archaeology or Biology. The Travelling Fellowship is open to women who are or have been members of any College or Approved Foundation or Approved Society in, or University Officers in, the University of Cambridge, but preference will be given to present or former members of Newnham College. The Travelling Fellowship will be available for all or part of the year 2016-2017 and the fund will pay research, travel and subsistence expenses normally up to £18,000 for the year. The proposed research must be post-doctoral, although students currently finishing PhD research are eligible to apply. Any award must be used for expenses in the field.
