



Student Award offered by the Cambridge Society for the Application of Research

The 2017 CSAR Student Award is now open for applications

The CSAR Student Award of £1000 is intended to recognise outstanding research in any discipline by PhD students currently studying at the University of Cambridge. The student is expected to clearly communicate their research in terms of real world applications. Selection of applicants will be at the discretion of a CSAR Student Award committee.

The applicant is initially required to submit a research description of up to 100 words, to be submitted online by **9th December 2016**. For further information contact csarscr@hermes.cam.ac.uk. In the case where work has been undertaken as part of a team, the applicant is required to include an estimate of their personal contribution to the project as a whole, and include contact information for a team leader to verify their involvement. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to give a ten minute presentation on their research findings to the committee. Interviews are expected to take place in **late February 2017**, exact dates will be confirmed nearer the time.

Successful candidates will receive their Award at a ceremony in the spring of 2017. In addition to providing financial support, CSAR will endeavour to provide opportunities for CSAR award recipients to meet with influential professionals in their areas of interest and to provide opportunities for personal development through direct personal interaction with senior members of the University of Cambridge and other organisations. This is expected to include an opportunity to meet with the Vice-Chancellor of the University in **early March 2017**.

In return, recipients will be asked to present their work as a five to ten-minute presentation at a regular CSAR lecture evening in the 2017-2018 academic year. Subsequently this presentation will be posted on the CSAR website. If the recipient's time permits, award recipients may be invited to present research to aspiring academics in schools around Cambridge, and/or participate in the selection committee for future CSAR Awards.
